



## USAF - F15 EAGLE

- #1 CUT ALL PIECES AND MARK THE BACK SIDE WITH THE APPROPRIATE LETTER FOR FUTURE REFERENCE. NOTE: ALWAYS CUT SLIGHTLY ON THE COLOR SIDE FOR A SMOOTHER SEAM.
- #2 ON PIECE A FOLD THE GREY LEADING EDGE TABS TO FORM A CREASE. DO NOT GLUE NOW. SEE FIGURE 1.
- #3 ON PIECE B MAKE SURE THE TWO L SHAPED CUTS ARE MADE AT THE REAR OF THE FUSELAGE. FIGURE 2





FOLD THESE TABS BACK AND GLUE THE TWO NONCOLOR SIDES TOGETHER.

#4 NEXT FOLD THE WINGS AND FUSELAGE ALONG THE BLACK FOLD LINES AND FOLD THE WHITE TABS BACK. NOTE: ALL WHITE TABS ARE TO BE FOLDED BACK AT A 90 DEG ANGLE


GLUE THE FRONT WHITE TABS TO THE INSIDE TO FORM A BOX TYPE ASSEMBLY.

#5 NEXT GLUE PARTS A & B TOGETHER BACK TO BACK CAREFULLY MATCHING THE



OUTLINES. NOTE: USE THE GREY LEADING EDGE TABS TO HELP ALIGN THE PARTS, NEXT GLUE THE REAR WHITE TABS TO UNDERNEATH SIDE OF PART A. THEN FOLD BACK AND GLUE THE COLORED TABS INTO PLACE.


#6 NEXT FOLD AND GLUE THE TWO TAILS "PART C" DOWN THE CENTER LINE CAREFULLY ALIGNING THE EDGES. FOLD THE MOUNTING TABS OUT AND GLUE TO THE FUSELAGE.SEE FIGURE 4.






- #6 NEXT GLUE THE THE MATCHING EXHAUST TOGETHER AS SHOWN IN FIGURE 5. WHEN THE GLUE IS DRY ENOUGH ROLL THE PIECE SO YOU CAN GLUE THE WHITE TAB TO THE OTHER SIDE. SEE FIGURE 6.
- #7 THE EXHAUSTS ARE THEN GLUED TO
  THE FUSELAGE. MATCH THE COLORS
  PATTERNS OF THE PIECES TO THE COLORS OF
  THE FUSELAGE.

#10 NOW GLUE THE NOSE
WEIGHT TO THE FRONT
FUSELAGE. SLIDE THE
NOSE WEIGHT UNDER THE
WHITE TABS OF THE FRONT



FUSELAGE TAKE CARE TO ATTACH IT STRAIGHT. GLUE (PART F)
ON TO (PART G). MAKE SURE THE PAINT MARKINGS MATCH UP.
#11NOW GLUE THE FORWARD FUSLAGE TO THE MAIN FUSLAGE IN
THE SAME WAY YOU GLUED THE EXHAUSTS ON.

#12TAKE (PART H) AND FOLD THE WIND SCREEN ALONG THE GREEN LINES.NEXT ROLL IT INTO U SHAPE AND TUCK AND GLUE THE WHITE TABS. FOLD THE MOUNTING TABS OUT AND GLUE THE CANOPY TO THE FUSELAGE.

NOTE: FOR YOUNGER CHILDREN YOU MAY WANT TO ROUND OFF THE NOSE AND ADD MORE WEIGHT TO COMPENSATE
